# Chief Joseph & Dr. Laralyn RiverWind



The RiverWinds have been ordained ministers since 2007. In 2018, they were appointed as “Ambassadors of God” by Member of the Knesset Yehuda Glick in Jerusalem at its 70th rebirthday. Joseph holds a Master’s Degree in Biblical Studies. Laralyn is a Doctor of Naturopathy and a Master Herbalist. Joseph RiverWind is the Peace Chief (formerly the War Chief) of the Northern Arawak Tribal Nation. He is a honorably discharged U.S. Army veteran. Laralyn RiverWind has bloodlines from the Creek, Cherokee, Irish and Scottish tribes. She is the Ambassador for the Northern Arawak Tribal Nation. Both of the RiverWinds have Sephardic ancestry through their mothers.

The RiverWinds are singers, enjoying praise and worship: playing the guitar, Celtic harp, Native American flutes and drums, bagpipes, keyboard and rattles. They are national award-winning musicians under their former band The Blessed Blend: 2011 Native American Music Award (Best Rock Recording) and the 2013 Taino Award’s Musician of the Year.

Joseph worked on the top secret weapons designs program Force XXI, responsible for the development of the radar technology used Israel’s Iron Dome. Laralyn spent time on the mission field as a child. From surviving maritime mishaps and avoiding multiple kidnapping attempts to being the escaped target of a serial killer, she has gleaned a healthy dose of life experience in what she calls her “adventures.” They have been in ministry together since 2004.
